

NEW LIFE

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, illegal drugs and non-prescribed medications are prohibited. Consequences will be immediate dismissal from the New Life program.
2. Weapons of any kind (i.e., firearms, knives, clubs, etc.) are prohibited on New Life property or in your possession. Consequences will be immediate dismissal from the New Life Program.
3. Fighting or threats of any kind and any inappropriate behavior is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate dismissal.
4. Any sexually related incident will be grounds for immediate dismissal.
5. Students are responsible for maintaining appropriate personal hygiene and maintaining their own personal environment (i.e., bathing, bed making, clothing, etc.). Failure to comply will result in a written warning (“write up”)
6. Students will receive a written warning (“write up”) for possessing items considered contraband.
7. Students are required to attend church services, groups, classes and functions. Failure to attend or chronic tardiness will result in a staffing conference and written warning (“write up”).
8. Students are to dress appropriately at all times. A written warning (“write up”) will be given for non-compliance.
9. Verbal abuse toward New Life staff or other students will not be tolerated and will result in appropriate disciplinary action.
10. Leaving the New Life Program before completion or without the express permission of the Program Director will result in immediate dismissal from the New Life Program.
11. Students may be subjected to periodic house searches and inspections. This will include bedrooms, bathrooms and personal property. Items that are considered contraband will be confiscated and disposed of. A written warning (“write up”) will be given for each incident with appropriate action being taken.
12. Packages brought in from the outside will be searched by the New Life staff and cleared before being brought into the Program.
13. Any disciplinary action taken will be based on the guidelines established by New Life.

NOTE: Excessive “write ups” will result in the loss of privileges and/or other disciplinary action(s) being taken.
